Our 4th Annual Bike Run and Walk will take place on Saturday, August 7th. This year we have chosen to support The Emmaus Project which is a social outreach project that supports other programs in the Trinity/Conception area such as MRON and Youth Addictions and has recently partnered with the Baccalieu Advisory Board to give leadership to an "Emergency Shelter Project" for people in crisis in the Trinity Conception region.

Besides these social programs, The Emmaus Project also includes the daily cafe, Seniors' and Youth Cafe and programs such as parenting, marriage, bereavement, divorce and separation, addictions and now under construction, new multi-purpose conference rooms to serve our area. This project serves all people of our region and is a very worthwhile cause!

Also this year, Cupids 400 Inc is on board as a major sponsor so there will be a theme running throughout the event commemorating the 400th Anniversary of Cupids. Our event will include a motorcycle parade through Cupids along with a tour of the new Legacy Center, a motorcycle ride along the Baccalieu Trail plus a walk through Cupids for those not riding, live entertainment, BBQ supper and many great prizes. We will be including a silent auction as well on a small scale so lots of things to see and do this year!! We may even have a visit from John Guy himself!!

Registration will be \$25 per person which includes all of the things mentioned above plus 1 ticket on our prize draws.

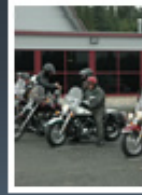
Pledge levels and prizes are as follows:

Itinerary

Our ride will leave approx 10:00am on Saturday, August 7th (rain or shine) with plans for a short stop at Monty's in Whitbourne before heading to Brown's Restaurant in Whiteway for lunch. Full menu will be offered so choice of lunch will be yours at your cost.

We will then leave at approx 12:30pm for Tim Horton's in Carbonear for another short rest stop before proceeding on back to Cupids. We should get back to Cupids at approx 2:00pm.

When we arrive at Cupids we will parade the bikes through the town on down to Burnt Head and back to the Cupids Legacy Center where you will have a chance to mingle and show off your rides!!

For those interested in touring the Legacy Center and Dig Site, there is a group rate of \$9.00 but we will pick up \$5.00 towards the cost so you will only be responsible for \$4.00.

Regular price for admission is \$11.50 so this will be a fantastic opportunity to see this beautiful facility at this reduced price.

For those walking, participants will leave the Emmaus Cafe approx 1:00 and walk to the Legacy Center. This group will be taken through first before the riders get there in order to keep the tour group to a manageable size.

Also note, transportation back to the Cafe will be provided for those walking.

At approx 3:30pm we will proceed back to the Emmaus Cafe where we will be treated to some great live music and our silent auction followed by our BBQ and prize draws at approx 5:00-6:00pm.
